18 Drive, Glendale Arizona 85301, commencing on Monday, February 28, 2022, at 1:00  
19 p.m., and will continue each weekday on Tuesday, March 1, 2022, through March 4, 2022,  
20 as necessary, at the same location beginning at 9:00 a.m. on each day, unless a tour is  
21 taken. If a tour is taken, it will begin on an alternative date and time set by the Chairman  
22 of the Committee (“Chairman”). Public comment may be taken during the hearing at  
23 times designated by the Chairman.

24 The hearing may conclude earlier or later than anticipated, depending upon the  
25 number of parties that intervene, the amount of testimony presented, the amount of public  
26 comment, and the time needed for deliberations by the Committee. As part of the public

- 20 9. Vote and decision concerning findings of fact, conclusions of law, the

22 environmental compatibility;
