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NOTICE OF HEARING

A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD before the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee (“Committee”) regarding the Application of RE Papago, LLC, for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility (“CEC”) authorizing construction of **one (1) 34.5/500kV substation and approximately 0.3-mile long 500kV gen-tie transmission line (collectively, the “RE Papago LLC Gen-tie Project”)** interconnecting a proposed photovoltaic (PV) solar generating and storage facility to the existing Delaney 500kV substation in Section 25, T2N, R8W, G&SRBM, Maricopa

1 County, approximately 5.5 miles west of Tonopah, Maricopa County, Arizona. A map of
2 the location of the RE Papago Gen-tie Project is attached here as “Exhibit A”.

5 **Monday, June 21, 2021 at 1:00 p.m. and continue as necessary on Tuesday, June 22,**
6 **2021 and Wednesday, June 23, 2021 at 9:30 a.m. respectively.** The hearing will
7 adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. or earlier at the discretion of the Committee Chairman.

19 Each county and municipal government and state agency interested in the proposed RE
20 Papago LLC Gen-tie Project and desiring to be a party to the proceedings shall, not less
21 than ten days before the date set for hearing, file with the Director of Utilities, Arizona
22 Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007 a notice
23 of intent to be a party.

24 Any domestic non-profit corporation or association formed in whole or in part to
25 promote conservation of natural beauty, to protect the environment, personal health or
26 other biological values, to preserve historical sites, to promote consumer interests, to
27 represent commercial and industrial groups, or to promote the orderly development of the

1 area in which the Project are to be located and desiring to become a party to the
2 proceedings shall, not less than ten days before the date set for hearing, file with the
3 Director of Utilities, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington Street,
4 Phoenix, Arizona 85007 a notice of intent to be a party.

5 The Committee or its Chairman, at any time deemed appropriate, may make other
6 persons parties to the proceeding.

7 Any person may make a limited appearance at a hearing by filing a statement in writing
8 with the Director of Utilities, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington
9 Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, not less than five days before the date set for hearing. A
10 person making a limited appearance shall not be a party or have the right to present
11 testimony or cross-examine witnesses.

12 This proceeding is governed by Arizona Revised Statutes Sections 40-360 to 40-360.13
13 and Arizona Administrative Code R14-3-201 to R14-3-220. No substantive
14 communication not in the public record may be made to any member of the Committee.
15 The written decision of the Committee will be submitted to the Arizona Corporation
16 Commission pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Section 40-360.07. Any person
17 intending to be a party to the proceedings on these matters before the Arizona Corporation
18 Commission must be a party to the proceedings before the Committee.


