2 by the Committee.

3 No tour of the Project Area is planned by the Chairman at this time. If the

8 At the public meeting/hearing, the Committee may consider, discuss, deliberate
9 and/or vote on the matters on the agenda. Items on the agenda may be taken in a different
10 order than listed as conditions require:

- 12 2. Roll call;
- 13 3. Consideration of and vote upon any requests to intervene;
- 14 4. Hearing on the Application including taking sworn testimony and
15 considering evidence presented by Applicant and other parties;
- 16 5. Public comment at the discretion of the Chairman;
- 17 6. Discussion of potential value of a tour of the proposed route;
- 18 7. If it is decided a tour would be valuable, the Committee will meet at the
19 hearing site. The members of the Committee will tour the project. Members
20 of the public may follow the Committee’s tour. No testimony or discussion
21 with or between Committee members about the application or matters
22 relating to the application will take place, except on the record before a court
23 reporter at the designated stops. The Chairman will make any procedural
24 decisions concerning stops at different points of interest;
- 25 8. Discussion of proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, the certificate of
26 environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of
27 environmental compatibility;
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9. Vote and decision concerning findings of fact, conclusions of law, the certificate of environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of environmental compatibility;

10. Adjournment.


