Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the general public, the parties and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee (“Committee”), that the Committee will hold a public meeting/hearing on the above application that is open to the public at the Hampton Inn and Suites Phoenix-Goodyear, located at 2000 North Litchfield Road, Goodyear, Arizona 85395, commencing on Monday, September 19, 2022, at 1:00 p.m., and will continue each weekday on Tuesday, September 20, 2022 through Thursday, September 22, 2022, as necessary, at the same location beginning at 9:00 a.m. on each day. No tour of the Project area is planned by the Chairman at this time. If the Chairman or Committee later decide to conduct a tour, notice that includes a map and itinerary of any such tour will be available at the hearing and posted on the Project website at <https://www.longroadenergy.com/sun-streams-expansion-gen-tie-project/> and the ACC website at: <https://www.azcc.gov/arizona-power-plant/meeting-schedule>.

5 comment, and the time needed for deliberations by the Committee. As a part of the public
6 meeting/hearing, members of the Committee will discuss the potential value of a tour, and,
7 at the discretion of the Chairman, may tour the location of the proposed project area as set
8 forth above.

22 relating to the application will take place, except on the record before a court
23 reporter at the designated stops. The Chairman will make any procedural
24 decisions concerning stops at different points of interest;

26 environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of
27 environmental compatibility;
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9. Vote and decision concerning findings of fact, conclusions of law, the certificate of environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of environmental compatibility;
