Bob Stump Appointed to NARUC Board of Directors

PHOENIX, AZ—Arizona Corporation Commissioner Bob Stump has been appointed to the National Association of Regulatory Commissioners (NARUC) Board of Directors by NARUC President Tony Clark. In this position, Stump will help oversee NARUC's general and financial functions and approve resolutions that set the Association's policies. His term on the Board will expire on October 31, 2012.

"I want to thank President Clark for the privilege of serving on the Board of NARUC," said Commissioner Stump. "I am honored to represent Arizona's voice on the Board and to help further the great work of this important organization."

Commissioner Stump was elected to the Arizona Corporation Commission in 2008. Prior to his election to the ACC, Commissioner Stump represented District 9 in the Arizona House of Representatives from 2002-2008. Commissioner Stump holds degrees from Harvard University and the University of California at Berkeley.

NARUC is a non-profit organization founded in 1889 whose members include the governmental agencies that are engaged in the regulation of utilities and carriers in the fifty States, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands. NARUC's member agencies regulate telecommunications, energy, and water utilities.
