Commission Unveils New Website with Interactive Features *Provides Tools to Improve Accessibility to the Public*

PHOENIX, AZ -- The Arizona Corporation Commission (ACC) has launched a new website designed to make information more easily accessible to the public and to give people the tools to become more involved in Commission activities.

To enhance the ease of use, the main page links to the areas of the website that provide the top services people come to the site to perform, such as where to go to incorporate your business or file corporations documents, how to get information about safe investing, how to get help with your utility company, and calendars and agendas for upcoming meetings.

“Arizonans should visit the Corporation Commission’s new website, which will make Commission documents and public events more accessible to all,” said Chairman Bob Stump.

New interactive features include:

- A subscription service so that now, anyone can sign up to receive the Commission’s agendas and press releases. Simply, click on “Sign up for Notices and Press Releases” and provide an email address. Every time an agenda or press release is issued, subscribers will simultaneously receive it in their email in-box.
- The ability to provide public comment through an online form by clicking “Submit a Public Comment.”
- Streaming audio and video of its meetings held in its Phoenix and Tucson offices.
- Informational videos including an overview of the Commission and its constitutionally-mandated duties, consumer tips, instructional videos for utility companies, etc.
- All filings in Commission cases are available on the website through its eDocket system,
- Coming soon, the public and interested parties will be able to sign up online to speak at Open Meetings.

The Commission hopes that the new website will be easy to navigate, enhance the Commission’s services, and that it will make information the public needs more readily available.
