Commission Approves Upgrades at Four Union Pacific Railroad Crossings in Santa Cruz County

(Phoenix) The Arizona Corporation Commission approved nearly \$1.4 million in upgrades to four Union Pacific Railroad crossings in Nogales. The upgrades will enhance safety and traffic flow.

The upgrades will take place at Baffert Drive, Calle Sonora, Bankard Avenue, and Morley Avenue. Each crossing will get new automatic gates with flashing LED lights. The Commission's Railroad Safety Division works with the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) and municipalities to identify crossings in need of improvements. The total cost of the upgrades is \$1,360,000 and are funded by the Federal Highway Administration.

Commission Approves Utility Service Expansion Trico Electric Cooperative will Expand its Service Area in Pinal County

(Phoenix) Arizona Corporation Commissioners gave Trico Electric Cooperative the go-ahead to expand its services in Pinal County.

Trico, a non-profit and member owned cooperative, currently serves more than 43,000 meters. The extension will cover an area 35 miles northwest of Tucson where two master planned communities will be developed. Sundance Ridge community will be comprised of 1,650 acres and the SaddleBrooke division another 51 acres. Trico already serves customers in the earlier phases of those communities' developments.
