Commission Names Ted Vogt Executive Director

(Phoenix) The Arizona Corporation Commission has appointed Ted Vogt Executive Director. Vogt who has a long political career in the state most recently served as Director of Legislative and Regulatory Affairs for Traversant Group, a lobbying group which provides consulting for legislative, sales, and business.

Prior Vogt served as the Chief of Operations in the Ducey Administration where he played an instrumental role in transforming the state's government operations. Vogt served as Director of the Arizona Department of Veterans' Services. He was Vice-Chairman of the House Ways and Means committee and served on the House Judiciary Committing and the Higher Education, Innovation and Reform committee. He also served as State Representative for District 30 from 2011 to 2013, successfully sponsoring 18 bills into law.

"It is an honor to take on this new role," said Vogt. "The Commission is vital for providing safe reliable services to all residents, and it is an avenue to promote a strong economy. I look forward to working with this Commission to serve our customers with the excellence they have come to expect."

Vogt served in the Air Force and was deployed to Afghanistan to support Operation Enduring Freedom. Prior to joining the Air Force, he worked as an executive assistant to then-former Secretary of Defense Donald Rumsfeld. Vogt earned his B.A. from Yale University and his law degree from the University of Arizona. Vogt replaces Jodi Jerich who served as Executive Director for the past four years
