Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the general public, the parties and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee ("Committee"), that the Committee will hold a public meeting/hearing on the above application that is open to the public at the Northwest Fire Department Training Facility, located at 5125 West Camino de Fuego, Tucson. Arizona 85743, commencing on Monday, June 6, 2022, at 1:00 p.m., and will continue each weekday on Tuesday, June 7, 2022, through Friday, June 10, 2002, as necessary, at the same location beginning at 9:00 a.m. on each day. No tour of the Project area is planned at this time. If the Chairman or Committee later decide to conduct a tour, an alternative date and time will be set by the Chairman.
