24 hearing site. The members of the Committee will tour the project. Members
25 of the public may follow the Committee's tour. No testimony or discussion
26 with or between Committee members about the application or matters
27 relating to the application will take place, except on the record before a court
28 reporter at the designated stops. The Chairman will make any procedural
decisions concerning stops at different points of interest;

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- 8. Discussion of proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, the certificate of environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of environmental compatibility;
- 9. Vote and decision concerning findings of fact, conclusions of law, the certificate of environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of environmental compatibility;
