13 Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the
14 general public, the parties and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line
15 Siting Committee ("Committee") that the Committee will hold a meeting/hearing on
16 the above application that is open to the public at the Hampton Inn and Suites
17 Kingman located at 1791 Sycamore Avenue, Kingman, Arizona 86409. Telephone:
18 928-692-0200. The hearing will begin on Tuesday, September 18, 2012 at 9:30 a.m.
19 and will continue on Wednesday, September 19, 2012, beginning at 9:30 a.m.,
20 unless a tour is taken. If a tour is taken, the tour will begin on Wednesday,
21 September 19, 2012 at 8:00 a.m. or at a later time set by the Chairman of the
22 Committee. If necessary, the hearing will continue on Thursday, September 20,
23 2012, beginning at 9:30 a.m. Public comment may be taken during the hearing at
24 times designated by the Chairman. Public comment also will be taken in a special
25 evening session on September 18, 2012, beginning at 6:00 p.m. at the same
26 location. Unless later ordered by the Chairman, the hearing will adjourn at
27 approximately 5:00 p.m. except on September 18, when it will continue after 6:00
p.m. for the public comment session. Public comment also may be taken during the
hearing at times designated by the Chairman. Additional days for the hearing may
be set, and the hearing may conclude earlier or later than anticipated, depending
upon the number of parties that intervene, the amount of testimony presented, the
amount of public comment, and the time needed for deliberations by the Committee.
As a part of the public meeting/hearing, members of the Committee will discuss the
potential value of a tour, and, at the discretion of the Chairman of the Committee,
may tour the proposed transmission line route for the project on September 19,
2011, beginning at 8:00


1 a.m. At the meeting/hearing, the Committee may consider, discuss, deliberate
2 and/or vote on the matters on the Agenda. Items on the Agenda may be taken in a
3 different order than listed as conditions require.

- 4 1. Call to Order;
- 5 2. Roll Call;
- 6 3. Consideration of and vote upon any requests to intervene;
- 7 4. Hearing on the application;
- 8 5. Public Comment at the discretion of the Chairman;
- 9 6. Discussion of potential value of a tour of the proposed route;
- 10 7. If the Chairman decides a tour would be valuable, the Committee will travel
11 along the route, following an itinerary which will be available at the hearing. A
12 detailed description of the tour route and itinerary, including a map, will be on
13 file at the Arizona Corporation Commission. Members of the public may follow
14 the Committee's tour by use of their own private vehicles. No testimony or
15 discussion with or between Committee Members about the Application or
16 matters relating to the Application will take place, except on the record before
17 a court reporter at the designated stops. The Chairman of the Committee will
18 make any procedural decisions necessary concerning the stops at the
19 different points of interest on the tour;

21 of Environmental Compatibility and conditions to the Certificate of
22 Environmental Compatibility;
- 23 9. Vote and decision concerning Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, the
