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23 Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the
24 general public, the parties and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting
25 Committee (“Committee”), that the Committee will hold a public meeting/hearing on
26 the above application that is open to the public at Comfort Suites Hotel, 15575 West

1 Roosevelt Road, Goodyear, Arizona 85338, commencing on Tuesday, September 24,
2 2019 at 1:00 p.m., and will continue each weekday on Wednesday, September 25, 2019
3 through Friday, September 27, 2019, as necessary, at the same location beginning at
4 9:00 a.m. on each day, unless a tour is taken. If a tour is taken, it will begin on
5 September 25, 2019, at approximately 9:00 a.m. or an alternative date and time set by
6 the Chairman of the Committee (“Chairman”). Public comment will be taken in a
7 special evening session on September 24, 2019 at 5:30 p.m. and may be taken at the
8 beginning of each hearing day or at other times during the hearing at times designated
9 by the Chairman. Unless later ordered by the Chairman, the hearing will adjourn at
10 approximately 5:00 p.m. each day.

11 Additional days for the hearing may be set, and the hearing may conclude earlier
12 or later than anticipated, depending upon the number of parties that intervene, the
13 amount of testimony presented, the amount of public comment, and the time needed for
14 deliberations by the Committee. As a part of the public meeting/hearing, members of
15 the Committee will discuss the potential value of a tour, and, at the discretion of the
16 Chairman, may tour the location of the proposed power plants and transmission lines for
17 the project as set forth above.

18 At the public meeting/hearing, the Committee may consider, discuss, deliberate
19 and/or vote on the matters on the agenda. Items on the agenda may be taken in a
20 different order than listed as conditions require:

- 21 1. Call to order;
- 22 2. Roll call;
- 23 3. Consideration of and vote upon any requests to intervene;
- 24 4. Hearing on the application;
- 25 5. Public comment at the discretion of the Chairman;
- 26 6. Discussion of potential value of a tour of the proposed route;

- 1 7. If it is decided a tour would be valuable, the Committee will meet at the
2 hearing site. The members of the Committee will tour the project. Members
3 of the public may follow the Committee's tour. No testimony or discussion
4 with or between Committee members about the application or matters relating
5 to the application will take place, except on the record before a court reporter
6 at the designated stops. The Chairman will make any procedural decisions
7 concerning stops at different points of interest;
- 8 8. Discussion of proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, the certificate of
9 environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of
10 environmental compatibility;
- 11 9. Vote and decision concerning findings of fact, conclusions of law, the
12 certificate of environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of
13 environmental compatibility;
- 14 10. Adjournment.
