Commission Revokes Securities Salesman Registration and Investment Adviser Representative License of California Man

PHOENIX – The Arizona Corporation Commission revoked the Arizona securities salesman registration and investment adviser representative license of J. Randall Gladden of California based upon his one-year disciplinary suspension by a self-regulatory organization, the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority (FINRA).

According to the FINRA order, Gladden solicited his clients to invest more than \$2.1 million in a church financing business controlled by him, which was an investment program not approved by his securities dealer. Besides the suspension, FINRA imposed a \$15,000 fine upon Gladden. The Commission found the revocations of Gladden's Arizona registration and license to be appropriate, in the public best interest and necessary for the protection of investors.

Determining whether an alternative investment program is a security is not always easy to determine and depends upon the unique facts and circumstances of the transaction and not on what a promoter calls the investment product.
