(Phoenix) The Arizona Corporation Commission's Safety Division is making more strides in order to protect the public. For the first time, the Safety Division held a CPR training for all of its inspectors and administration staff.

"We are out in the public every day," said Safety Division Director John Mazza. "We have inspectors along the railroads and pipelines and at master-meters like at hotels, mobile home parks, and schools. We can't pick and choose which safety issues may present themselves to us. As safety professionals this training is one more tool in our belt to keep our inspectors and Arizonans safe."

There are 24 inspectors in the Safety Division. They were trained on first aid, self-aid, CPR and on Automatic External Defibrillators (AED). Established by Article 15 of the state's constitution, the Arizona Corporation Commission is responsible for the regulation of public utilities, overseeing the incorporation or registration of companies wishing to do business in Arizona. Additionally, the Corporation Commission registers and oversees securities offerings and dealers, and enforces railroad and pipeline safety. The five commissioners that make up the Commission are elected by the people of Arizona for a four-year term, with the option of serving for two consecutive terms.
