PART D. NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

- 1. Estimated unbilled revenue for 2018 not reported in Part C Line 20 for Revenue Classes 1-7 is \$1,280,000. Reported for 2017 was \$1,095,000.
- 2. Trico has developed a plan to replace 100% of the automated meters and equipment by the end of 2020. The Depreciation Expense includes an additional \$3 million for 2018 and \$5 million for 2017 in order to increase the provision for depreciation account for meters which will allow for full retirement of current meters recorded in plant. For 2018, \$1.5 million of the \$3 million was recorded in the month of December, which caused a negative margin in December.
- 3. For 2018, the Accounts Receivable-Other reflections \$15,296,743 million that is due to Trico Electric from Trico's subsidiary company, AVION Solar, LLC. Trico used its own cash and short-term financing for the construction of a 10 MW solar generating system for AVION Solar, LLC.
