Exceptions include the following months: April, May, July, and September. In April, the local fire department was filling water tenders for fighting a wildfire. In May, the local fire department was filling water tenders for Engineer testing and fighting wildfires. In July, water was used to flush a mian line due to a large leak on Kiowa. In September, water was used to flush a main line due to a large leak on Cayuga. The number of estimate authorized gallons is listed in the chart above.
