13 conditions require.



18 own private vehicles. No testimony or discussion with or between Committee  
19 Members about the Application or matters relating to the Application will take place,  
20 except on the record before a court reporter at the designated stops. The Chairman of  
21 the Committee will make any procedural decisions concerning stops at different points  
22 of interest;
