15 Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the
16 general public, the parties and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting
17 Committee ("Committee"), that the Committee will hold a public meeting/hearing on the
18 above application that is open to the public at the Crowne Plaza Phoenix Chandler
19 Resort, 1 N. San Marcos Place, Chandler, Arizona 85225, commencing on Monday,
20 July 24, 2017 at 10:00 a.m., and will continue each weekday on Tuesday, July 25,
21 2017 through Thursday, July 27, 2017, as necessary, at the same location beginning
22 at 9:00 a.m. on each day, unless a tour is taken. If a tour is taken, it will begin on
23 Tuesday, July 25, 2017, at approximately 9:00 a.m. or an alternative date and time set
24 by the Chairman of the Committee ("Chairman"). Public comment will be taken in a
25 special evening session on July 24, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. and may be taken at the
26 beginning of each hearing day or at other times during the hearing at times designated
27 by the Chairman. Unless later ordered by the Chairman, the hearing will adjourn at
28 approximately 5:00 p.m. each day.

1 Additional days for the hearing may be set, and the hearing may conclude
2 earlier or later than anticipated, depending upon the number of parties that intervene,
3 the amount of testimony presented, the amount of public comment, and the time
4 needed for deliberations by the Committee. As a part of the public meeting/hearing,
5 members of the Committee will discuss the potential value of a tour, and, at the
6 discretion of the Chairman, may tour the location of the proposed power plants and
7 transmission lines for the project as set forth above.


8 At the public meeting/hearing, the Committee may consider, discuss, deliberate
9 and/or vote on the matters on the agenda. Items on the agenda may be taken in a
10 different order than listed as conditions require:

- 11 1. Call to order;
- 12 2. Roll call;
- 13 3. Consideration of and vote upon any requests to intervene;
- 14 4. Hearing on the application;
- 15 5. Public comment at the discretion of the Chairman;
- 16 6. Discussion of potential value of a tour of the proposed route;
- 17 7. If it is decided a tour would be valuable, the Committee will meet at the
18 hearing site. The members of the Committee will tour the project. Members
19 of the public may follow the Committee's tour. No testimony or discussion
20 with or between Committee members about the application or matters
21 relating to the application will take place, except on the record before a court
reporter at the designated stops. The Chairman will make any procedural
decisions concerning stops at different points of interest;
- 22 8. Discussion of proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, the certificate of
23 environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of environmental
compatibility;
- 24 9. Vote and decision concerning findings of fact, conclusions of law, the
25 certificate of environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of
environmental compatibility; and
- 26 10. Adjournment.
