ACC HOLDING PUBLIC COMMENT SESSION ON WIND RIVER RESOURCES

PHOENIX – The Arizona Corporation Commission (ACC) will hold a public comment session for residents in and around Beaver Dam who would like to share comments and concerns about Wind River Resources' proposal to transport water from the Beaver Dam Wash to Mesquite, Nevada.

Wind River Resources has filed an application with the Arizona Department of Water Resources (ADWR) proposing to construct three wells in the Mormon Wells area along the Beaver Dam Wash to withdraw groundwater. The water would be transported by pipeline to the Virgin Valley Water District in Mesquite, Nevada. According to the application, the District serves a 312 square mile area within Clark County, Nevada.

The ACC regulates private water companies in Arizona, including the Beaver Dam Water Company, Littlefield Water Company, Biasi Water and other small water companies serving northern Mohave County. Because these companies and their customers could be affected by this proposal, the Commissioners would like to gather comment on the proposal in advance of the ADWR hearing, which starts on March 2.

Local officials and residents are invited to share their concerns with the Commissioners.

About Public Comment Sessions

Public comment sessions are formal proceedings and all comments will be tape recorded or transcribed by a court reporter. The Commissioners may limit the duration of each individual's comments to allow everyone a fair opportunity to speak.
