Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the general public, the parties, and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee (“Committee”), that the Committee will hold a public meeting/hearing on the above application that is open to the public at the Arizona Corporation Commission (“ACC”), commencing on October 16, 2024, at 1:00 p.m., and will continue on October 17, 2024, at the same location beginning at 9:00 a.m.

Public comment will be taken in a special evening session on October 16, 2024, at 5:30 p.m. and may be taken at the beginning of each hearing day or at other times during the hearing at times designated by the Chairman. Unless later ordered by the Chairman, the hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. each day, except on October 16, 2024, when it will continue after 5:30 p.m. for the public comment session.

No tour of the Project area is planned by the Chairman at this time. If the Chairman or Committee later decides to conduct a tour, notice that includes a map and itinerary of any such tour will be available at the hearing and posted on the Project website at <https://brightnightpower.com/eagle-eye-community/> and ACC website at: <https://www.azcc.gov/arizona-power-plant/meeting-schedule>.

The hearing may conclude earlier or later than anticipated, depending upon the number of parties that intervene, the amount of testimony presented, the amount of public comment, and the time needed for deliberations by the Committee. As a part of the public

1 meeting/hearing, members of the Committee will discuss the potential value of a tour, and,  
2 at the discretion of the Chairman, may tour the location of the proposed project area as set  
3 forth above.

6 **TELEPHONE.**

7 At least 24 hours in advance of the hearing, information regarding online and  
8 telephone hearing access as well as any additional details regarding safety protocols or  
9 other revisions to the hearing schedule, will be posted on the Applicant's Project website

11 <https://www.azcc.gov/arizona-power-plant/meeting-schedule>. The Chairman may, at his  
12 discretion, recess the hearing to a time and place to be announced during the hearing, or to  
13 be determined after the recess. The date, time, and place at which the hearing will be  
14 resumed will be posted on the above-noted Project and ACC websites. **NOTE: NOTICE**  
15 **OF ANY SUCH RESUMED HEARING WILL BE GIVEN; HOWEVER,**  
16 **PUBLISHED NOTICE OF SUCH A RESUMED HEARING IS NOT REQUIRED.**

17 **PUBLIC COMMENT WILL BE TAKEN IN A SPECIAL EVENING**  
18 **SESSION ON OCTOBER 16, 2024, BEGINNING AT 5:30, VIA TELEPHONE,**  
19 **ZOOM, OR IN PERSON AT THE ACC, 1200 WEST WASHINGTON STREET,**  
20 **PHOENIX, ARIZONA, 85007. PUBLIC COMMENT MAY ALSO BE TAKEN AT**  
21 **OTHER TIMES DURING THE HEARING AT THE DISCRETION OF THE**  
22 **COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN.**


1 At the public meeting/hearing, the Committee may consider, discuss, deliberate  
2 and/or vote on the matters on the agenda. Items on the agenda may be taken in a different  
3 order than listed as conditions require:

- 4 1. Call to order;
- 5 2. Roll call;
- 6 3. Consideration of and vote upon any requests to intervene;
- 7 4. Hearing on the application;
- 8 5. Public comment at the discretion of the Chairman;
- 9 6. Discussion of potential value of a tour of the proposed route;
- 10 7. If it is decided a tour would be valuable, the Committee will meet at the  
11 hearing site. The members of the Committee will tour the project. Members  
12 of the public may follow the Committee's tour. No testimony or discussion  
13 with or between Committee members about the application or matters  
14 relating to the application will take place, except on the record before a court  
15 reporter at the designated stops. The Chairman will make any procedural  
16 decisions concerning stops at different points of interest;
- 17 8. Discussion of proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, the certificate of  
18 environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of  
19 environmental compatibility;
- 20 9. Vote and decision concerning findings of fact, conclusions of law, the  
21 certificate of environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of  
22 environmental compatibility;
- 23 10. Adjournment.
