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NOTICE OF HEARING

A **PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD** before the Arizona Power Plant and
Transmission Line Siting Committee (“Committee”) regarding the Application of EAGL,
LLC (“Applicant”) for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility to authorize the
construction of the Eagle Eye Solar Generation Tie Line Project (“Project”). The Project
consists of an up to 2.1-mile 230-kilovolt (“kV”) transmission line and associated
interconnection facilities from the Eagle Eye Solar Project to the regional grid at the
existing Liberty to Parker 230-kV transmission lines. All Project components are located
in La Paz County, Arizona. A general location map of the Project is attached as Exhibit
A.

The hearing will be held at the Arizona Corporation Commission (“ACC”),
located at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona, 85007. **The hearing will
begin on Wednesday, October 16, 2024, at 1:00 p.m. and will continue on October
17, 2024, commencing at 9:00 a.m.** If any revisions to the hearing schedule are required,

6 COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN.

7 PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT ALL LOCAL AND STATE PUBLIC
8 HEALTH AND SAFETY GUIDELINES WILL BE FOLLOWED DURING THE
9 HEARING AND PUBLIC COMMENT SESSION. RESTRICTIONS ON PUBLIC
10 ACCESS, SAFETY PROTOCOLS, AND REVISIONS TO THE HEARING
11 SCHEDULE MAY OCCUR DUE TO PUBLIC HEALTH CONSIDERATIONS.

13 OR LISTEN TO THE HEARING VIA TELEPHONE. At least 24 hours in advance
14 of the hearing, information regarding online and telephone hearing access, as well as any
15 additional details regarding safety protocols or other revisions to the hearing schedule

18 to be announced during the hearing, or to be determined after recess. The date, time, and
19 place at which the hearing will be resumed will be posted on the above-noted Project and
20 ACC websites. **NOTE: NOTICE OF ANY SUCH RESUMED HEARING WILL BE**
21 **GIVEN; HOWEVER, PUBLISHED NOTICE OF SUCH A RESUMED HEARING**
22 **IS NOT REQUIRED.**

23 No tour is planned at this time. If the Committee decides to conduct a tour, notice
24 that includes a map and itinerary of any such tour will be available at the hearing and
25 posted on the Project website at: <https://brightnightpower.com/eagle-eye-community/> and
26 the ACC website at: www.azcc.gov/arizona-power-plant/meeting-schedule. Members of

1 the public may follow the Committee on the tour. During the tour, the Committee may
2 hear testimony at stops on the tour concerning what is visible at stops and the relevance
3 of the location and view to the Project. No other discussion or deliberation concerning the
4 Application will occur during the tour. A court reporter or recording device will record
5 any testimony taken on the tour for transcription. Public health and safety protocols
6 specific for the tour will be included on the itinerary.

18 set for the hearing, file a Notice of Intent to Become a Party with the Director of Utilities,
19 Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007.


20 Any domestic non-profit corporation or association formed in whole or in part to
21 promote conservation or natural beauty, to protect the environment, personal health, or
22 other biological values to preserve historical sites, to promote consumer interests, to
23 represent commercial and industrial groups, or to promote the orderly development of the
24 area in which the Project is located desiring to become a party to the proceedings shall,
25 not less than ten (10) days before the date set for the hearing, file Notice of Intent to

1 Become a Party with the Director of Utilities, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200
2 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007.

3 The Committee or the Chairman, at any time deemed appropriate, may make other
4 persons parties to the proceedings. Any person may make a limited appearance at the
5 hearing by filing a statement in writing with the Director of Utilities, Arizona
6 Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007, and the
7 Chairman of the Committee at 2005 North Central Avenue, Phoenix, AZ 85007, not less
8 than five (5) days before the date set for the hearing. A person making a limited
9 appearance will not be a party or have the right to present testimony or cross-examine
10 witnesses.

11 This proceeding governed by Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S.") §§ 40-360 to
12 40-360.13 and Arizona Administrative Code Rules ("A.A.C.") R14-3-201 to R14-3-220.
13 No substantive communication, not in the public record, may be made to any member of
14 the Committee. The written decision of the Committee will be submitted to the ACC
15 pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-360.07. Any person intending to be a party to the proceedings on
16 the matter before the ACC must be a party to the proceedings before the Committee.



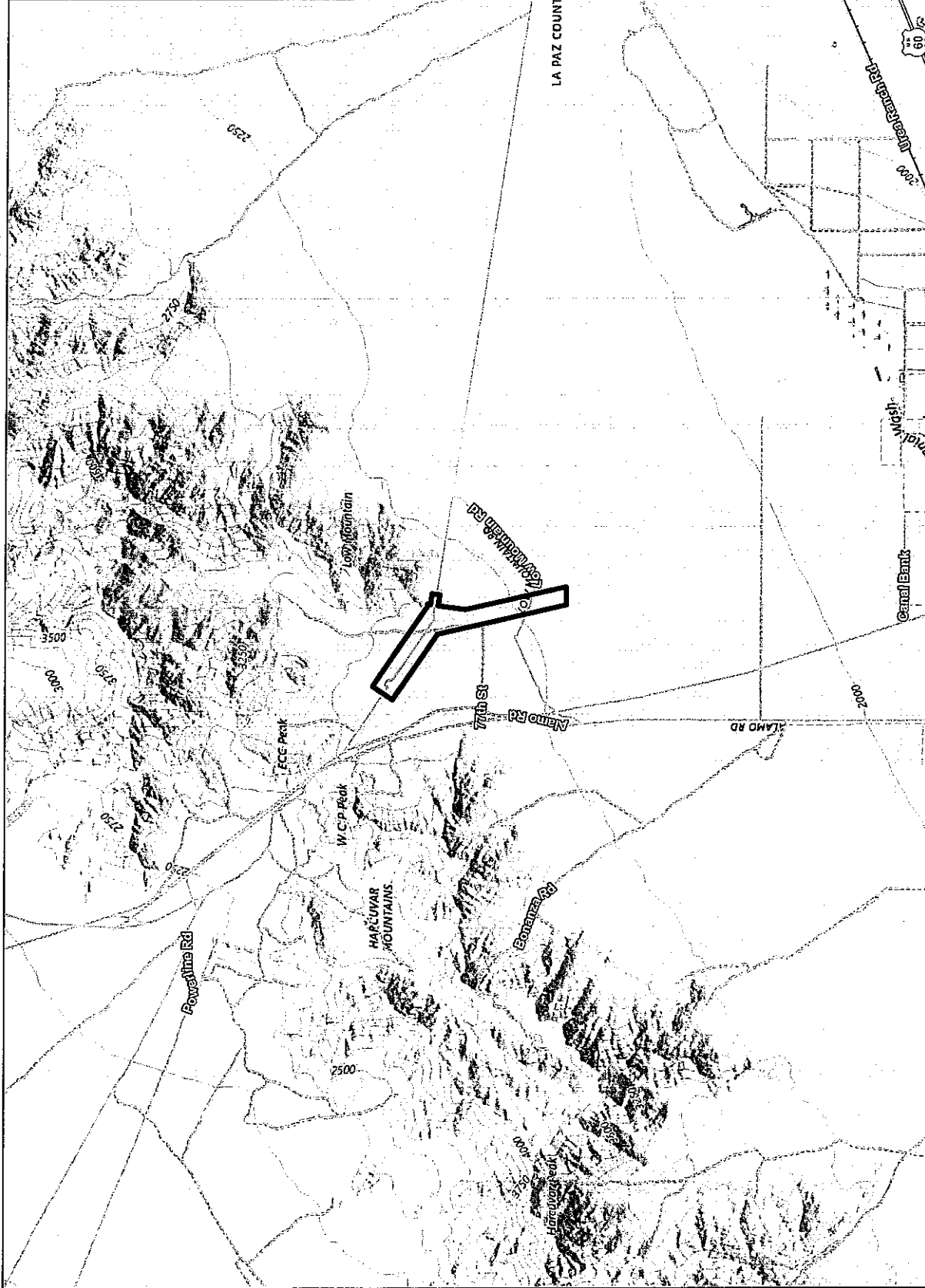
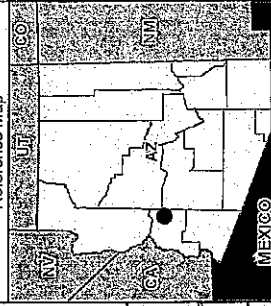
