Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the general public, the parties, and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee ("Committee"), that the Committee will hold a public meeting/hearing on the above application that is open to the public at Rancho de los Caballeros, located at 1551 South Vulture Mine Road, Wickenburg, Arizona 85390, commencing on October 28, 2024, at 1:00 p.m., and will continue each weekday on October 29, 2024, through November 1, 2024, as necessary, at the same location beginning at 9:00 a.m. on each day.

Public comment will be taken in a special evening session on October 28, 2024, at 5:30 p.m. and may be taken at the beginning of each hearing day or at other times during the hearing at times designated by the Chairman. Unless later ordered by the Chairman, the hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. each day, except on October 28, 2024, when it will continue after 5:30 p.m. for the public comment session.

No tour of the Project area is planned by the Chairman at this time.
