

26 Public comment will be taken in a special evening session on Monday, November 7, 2022, at 5:30 p.m. and may be taken at the beginning of each hearing day or at other 27 28 times during the hearing at times designated by the Chairman. Unless later ordered by the

Chairman, the hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. each day, except on 1 Monday, November 7, 2022, when it will continue after 5:00 p.m. for the public comment session.

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The hearing may conclude earlier or later than anticipated, depending upon the 4 number of parties that intervene, the amount of testimony presented, the amount of public 5 comment, and the time needed for deliberations by the Committee. As a part of the public 6 meeting/hearing, members of the Committee will discuss the potential value of a tour, and, 7 at the discretion of the Chairman, may tour the location of the proposed project area as set 8 forth above. 9
