There will be no hearing on November 11, 2021 due to the Veteran's Day holiday. If a tour is taken, it will begin on November 9, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. or an alternative date and time set by the Chairman of the Committee (Chairman). If necessary, the hearing will thereafter continue on November 15, 2021 through November 19, 2021, commencing at 9:00 a.m. each day as necessary

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PUBLIC COMMENT WILL BE TAKEN IN A SPECIAL EVENING SESSION ON NOVEMBER 8, 2021, BEGINNING AT 5:30 P.M. VIA TELEPHONE, ZOOM, OR IN PERSON, AT THE HILTON PHOENIX CHANDLER, LOCATED AT 2929 WEST FRYE ROAD, CHANDLER, ARIZONA 85224.
