NOTICE OF HEARING

A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD before the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee ("Committee") regarding the Application of Chimney Canyon Solar LLC ("Applicant") for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility ("CEC") to authorize construction of the Chimney Canyon Gen-Tie Line Project ("Project").

The Project will involve the construction of up to two 500 kilovolt ("kV") or 345 kV transmission lines that will connect a utility-scale photovoltaic solar array ("Solar Facility") and Battery Energy Storage System ("BESS") with the existing Arizona Public Service Company ("APS") Cholla Substation, and if necessary, the planned APS Sitgreaves Switchyard. The Project will electrically interconnect the Chimney Canyon Solar Facility

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and BESS to the existing APS Cholla Substation and/or the planned APS Sitgreaves Switchyard, providing solar and storage resources to the Arizona grid. The Project will be located near unincorporated Joseph City, Navajo County, Arizona. A map of the Project is attached as **Exhibit A**.

The hearing on the Application will be held at the Little America Hotel, Ponderosa Room, located at 2515 E. Butler Ave, Flagstaff, Arizona 86004. The hearing will begin on Monday, December 15, 2025, at 1:00 p.m. and will continue as necessary through Friday, December 19, 2025, beginning at 9:00 a.m. each day at the same location through the completion of the hearing. BUTLER AVE, FLAGSTAFF, AZ 86004. PUBLIC COMMENT MAY BE TAKEN AT THE BEGINNING OF EACH HEARING DAY, OR AT OTHER TIMES DURING THE HEARING, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN.

THE PUBLIC CAN WATCH THE HEARING ONLINE, LISTEN TO THE HEARING VIA TELEPHONE, OR ATTEND IN PERSON. 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GIVEN; HOWEVER, PUBLISHED NOTICE OF SUCH RESUMED HEARING IS NOT REQUIRED.

If the Committee decides to conduct a tour of the Project, notice that includes a map and itinerary of any such tour will be available at the hearing and posted on the Project and ACC websites. Members of the public may follow the Committee on the tour. During the tour, the Committee may hear testimony at stops on the tour concerning what is visible at stops and the relevance of the location and view to the Project. No other discussion or deliberation concerning the Application will occur during the tour. A court reporter or recording device will record any testimony taken on the tour for transcription. Public health and safety protocols specific for the tour will be included on the itinerary. If the Committee decides not to take a tour, the hearing will continue as scheduled.

Each county, municipal government, and state agency interested in the Project that desires to be a party to the proceedings shall, not less than ten (10) days before the date set for the hearing, file a Notice of Intent to Become a Party with the Director of the Utilities Division, ACC, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007.

Any domestic non-profit corporation or association formed in whole or in part to promote conservation or natural beauty; to protect the environment, personal health or other biological values; to preserve historical sites; to promote consumer interests; to represent commercial and industrial groups; or to promote the orderly development of the

area in which the Project is to be located desiring to become a party to the proceedings shall, not less than ten (10) days before the date set for the hearing, file a Notice of Intent to Become a Party with the Director of Utilities Division, ACC, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007.

The Committee may make other persons parties to the proceedings at any time. Any person may make a limited appearance at a hearing by filing a statement in writing with the Director of the Utilities Division, ACC, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007, and the Chairman of the Committee at 2005 North Central Avenue, Phoenix, AZ 85004, not less than five days (5) before the date set for the hearing. A person making a limited appearance will not be a party or have the right to present testimony or crossexamine witnesses.

This proceeding is governed by Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S.") §§ 40-360 to 40-360.13 and Arizona Administrative Code R14-3-201 to R14-3-220. No substantive communication, not in the public record, may be made to any member of the Committee. The written decision of the Committee will be submitted to the ACC pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-360.07. Any person intending to be a party to the proceedings on the matter before the ACC must be a party to the proceedings before the Committee.
