14 general public, the parties, and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting
15 Committee (“Committee”), that the Committee will hold a public meeting/hearing on the
16 above application that is open to the public at the Arizona Corporation Commission
17 (“Commission”), located at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007
18 commencing on Monday, February 10, 2025 at 10:00 a.m., and will continue on Tuesday,
19 February 11, 2025, beginning at 9:00 a.m. and then will continue, as necessary, on
20 Thursday, February 13, 2025 at 1:30 p.m. and Friday, February 14, 2025, at 9:00 a.m. at
21 the same location.

22 Public comment will be taken in a special evening session on February 10, 2025, at
23 5:30 p.m. and may be taken at the beginning of each hearing day or at other times during
24 the hearing at times designated by the Chairman. Unless later ordered by the Chairman,
25 the hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. each day, except on February 10,
26 2025, when it will continue after 5:30 p.m. for the public comment session.

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1 The hearing may conclude earlier or later than anticipated, depending upon the
2 number of parties that intervene, the amount of testimony presented, the amount of public
3 comment, and the time needed for deliberations by the Committee.
