13 Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the general public, the  
14 parties, and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee  
15 (“Committee”), that the Committee will hold a public meeting/hearing on the above  
16 application that is open to the public at the Windmill Suites, 12545 W. Bell Rd., Surprise,  
17 Arizona 85378, commencing on August 10, 2026, at 1:00 p.m., and will continue each  
18 weekday on August 11, 2026, through August 14, 2026, as necessary, at the same location  
19 beginning at 9:00 a.m. on each day, unless a tour is taken. If a tour is taken, it will begin  
20 on an alternative date and time set by the Chairman of the Committee (“Chairman”).

21 Public comment will be taken in a special evening session on August 10, 2026, at  
22 5:30 p.m. and may be taken at the beginning of each hearing day or at other times during  
23 the hearing at times designated by the Chairman. Unless later ordered by the Chairman,  
24 the hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. each day, except on August 10, 2026,  
25 when it will continue after 5:30 p.m. for the public comment session.

26 No tour of the Project area is planned by the Chairman at this time. If the  
27 Chairman or Committee later decides to conduct a tour, notice that includes a map and  
28 itinerary of any such tour will be available at the hearing and posted on the Project website

4 The hearing may conclude earlier or later than anticipated, depending upon the  
5 number of parties that intervene, the amount of testimony presented, the amount of public  
6 comment, and the time needed for deliberations by the Committee. As a part of the public  
7 meeting/hearing, members of the Committee will discuss the potential value of a tour and,  
8 at the discretion of the Chairman, may tour the location of the proposed project area as set  
9 forth above.

10 **THE PUBLIC HAS THE OPTION TO PARTICIPATE BY EITHER**  
11 **WATCHING THE MEETING ONLINE OR LISTENING TO THE MEETING VIA**  
12 **TELEPHONE.**

13 At least 24 hours in advance of the hearing, information regarding online and  
14 telephone hearing access as well as any additional details regarding safety protocols or  
15 other revisions to the hearing schedule, will be posted on the Applicant's Project website

18 Chairman may, at his discretion, recess the hearing to a time and place to be announced  
19 during the hearing, or to be determined after the recess. The date, time, and place at  
20 which the hearing will be resumed will be posted on the above-noted Project and ACC  
21 websites. **NOTE: NOTICE OF ANY SUCH RESUMED HEARING WILL BE**  
22 **GIVEN; HOWEVER, PUBLISHED NOTICE OF SUCH A RESUMED HEARING**  
23 **IS NOT REQUIRED.**

24 **PUBLIC COMMENT WILL BE TAKEN IN A SPECIAL EVENING**  
25 **SESSION ON MONDAY, AUGUST 10, 2026, BEGINNING AT 5:30 P.M., VIA**  
26 **TELEPHONE, ZOOM, OR IN PERSON AT THE WINDMILL SUITES, 12545 W**  
27 **BELL RD, SURPRISE, AZ 85378. PUBLIC COMMENT MAY BE TAKEN AT**  
28 **OTHER TIMES DURING THE HEARING AT THE DISCRETION OF THE**  
**CHAIRMAN.**

1           **THE PUBLIC CAN WATCH THE HEARING ONLINE, LISTEN TO THE**  
2 **HEARING VIA TELEPHONE, OR ATTEND IN PERSON.**

3           At the public meeting/hearing, the Committee may consider, discuss, deliberate,  
4 and/or vote on the matters on the agenda. Items on the agenda may be taken in a different  
5 order than listed as conditions require:

- 6           1.     Call to order;
- 7           2.     Roll call;
- 8           3.     Consideration of and vote upon any requests to intervene;
- 9           4.     Hearing on the application;
- 10          5.     Public comment at the discretion of the Chairman;
- 11          6.     Discussion of potential value of a tour of the proposed route;
- 12          7.     If it is decided a tour would be valuable, the Committee will meet at the  
13 hearing site. The members of the Committee will tour the project. Members  
14 of the public may follow the Committee's tour. No testimony or discussion  
15 with or between Committee members about the application or matters  
16 relating to the application will take place, except on the record before a court  
17 reporter at the designated stops. The Chairman will make any procedural  
18 decisions concerning stops at different points of interest;
- 19          8.     Discussion of proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, the certificate of  
20 environmental compatibility, and conditions to the certificate of  
21 environmental compatibility;
- 22          9.     Vote and decision concerning findings of fact, conclusions of law, the  
23 certificate of environmental compatibility, and conditions to the certificate  
24 of environmental compatibility;
- 25          10.    Adjournment.
