Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the general public, the parties, and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee ("Committee"), that the Committee will hold a public meeting/hearing on the above application that is open to the public at the Hilton Garden Inn, located at 11460 W. Hilton Way, Avondale, Arizona 85323, commencing on September 29, 2025, at 1:00 p.m., and will continue each weekday on September 30, 2025, through October 3, 2025, as necessary, at the same location beginning at 9:00 a.m. on each day, unless a tour is taken. If a tour is taken, it will begin on an alternative date and time set by the Chairman of the Committee ("Chairman"). Public comment will be taken in a special evening session on September 29, 2025, at 5:30 p.m. and may be taken at the beginning of each hearing day or at other times during the hearing at times designated by the Chairman.
