Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the general public, the parties and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee (“Committee”), that the Committee will hold a public meeting/hearing on the above application that is open to the public at the Biosphere 2, located at 32540 South Biosphere Road, Oracle, Arizona 85739, commencing on Tuesday, September 6, 2022, at 1:00 p.m., and will continue each weekday on Wednesday, September 7, 2022, through Tuesday, September 13, 2022, as necessary, at the same location beginning at 9:00 a.m. on each day. No tour of the Project area is planned by the Chairman at this time. If the Chairman or Committee later decide to conduct a tour, notice that includes a map and itinerary of any such tour will be available at the hearing and posted on the Project website at [sunzia.com](http://sunzia.com) and the ACC website at: <https://www.azcc.gov/arizona-power-plant/meeting-schedule>.

Public comment will be taken in a special evening session on Tuesday, September 6, 2022, at 5:30 p.m. Unless later ordered by the Chairman, the hearing will adjourn at

21           reporter at the designated stops. The Chairman will make any procedural  
22           decisions concerning stops at different points of interest;

24           environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of  
25           environmental compatibility;
- 26           9.     Vote and decision concerning findings of fact, conclusions of law, the

28           environmental compatibility;
10.    Adjournment.
