If necessary, the hearing will continue on Thursday, September 20, 2012, beginning at 9:30 a.m. Public comment may be taken during the hearing at times designated by the Chairman. Public comment also will be taken in a special evening session on September 18, 2012, beginning at 6:00 p.m. at the same location.
