- 2. The Total calculated above does not take into consideration the current charge or credit based on the Company's Purchase Power and Fuel Adjustment Clause (described below), or any surcharges the Commission approved in order for the Company to attempt to meet standards in renewable energy or energy efficiency that the Commission established (including the Renewable Energy Standard Surcharge or Energy Efficiency Surcharge).

#### PURCHASED POWER AND FUEL ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE

In addition to the base cost of purchase power, the Commission approved a Purchase Power and Fuel Adjustment Clause ("PPFAC") in Decision No. 49221 (August 2, 1978), as modified in Decision No. 52273 (July 13, 1981), Decision No. 56383 (March 9, 1989) and Decision No. 57767 (March 16, 1992). The PPFAC was modified in Decision No. 73737 in accordance with the Plan of Administration approved in that Decision and on file with the Arizona Corporation Commission. The PPFAC charge or credit ("PPFAC rate") is in addition to all other charges for electric service. The PPFAC rate may change from time to time based on future orders of the Commission and after review of MWE's fuel and purchase power costs.

#### TAXES AND ASSESSMENTS

In addition to all other rates and charges authorized by the Commission in Decision No. 73737, MWE will collect from its customers all applicable sales, transaction, privilege, regulatory and other taxes and assessments as may now or in the future apply.

#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

The Company has adopted the Rules and Regulations established by the Commission as the basis for its operating procedures. A.A.C. R14-2-201 through R14-2-213 will be controlling of Company procedures, unless subsequent Commission decisions provide otherwise.

#### 1. **AVAILABILITY**

The maximum footage allowance, which the Company shall provide at the initial installation of service, without charge to the customer will be as follows:

100 feet.

Non-residential: 0 feet.

#### 2. CONTRIBUTIONS IN AID OF CONSTRUCTION

All costs to the Company to provide the service line from the Company's distribution line to the customer's premises in excess of the maximum footage allowance specified in paragraph 1 above will be paid by the customer as contribution in aid of construction.

#### 3. REFUNDABLE METER ADVANCE.

The Company may require a refundable meter advance from any customer requesting service. The advance requirements will be \$50.00.

#### 4. REFUND

The meter advance is refundable at 10% of the annual net revenues from that meter and applied as a credit to the customer's November billing of each year until fully paid.

#### AUTHORIZED PRIMARY ELECTRIC SERVICE PROVIDERS

- Customers who elect unbundled service under the terms of this tariff shall be required to designate an
  Authorized Primary Electric Service Provider (APESP) and must comply with A.A.C. R14-2-1601(12),
  Direct Access Service Request. The APESP shall be responsible for arranging with the customer all
  services which may be required for electric service including services to be provided by the APESP, any
  other ESP or MWE.
- 2. The APESP shall not be authorized to provide any service to customers in MWE's certificated area unless it is:
  - a. the holder of a certificate of convenience and necessity to provide electric service provider service issued by the ACC; and
  - b. it has entered into a satisfactory interconnection agreement with MWE.
- 3. The interconnection agreement shall include, among other things, provisions concerning establishment of service, the deposit by the APESP of adequate security to operate in MWE's certificated area, indemnification, discontinuance of service for non-payment, service reestablishment, billing, collection, auditing of operations and related items.
- 4. All APESPs shall be required to pay to MWE an initial establishment charge of \$5.00 per customer pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-203. The provisions of A.A.C. R14-2-203 concerning other deposits and information on applicants for service shall be applicable to APESPs.
- 5. MWE is not responsible for any payment due to APESPs which it cannot collect when the customer selects MWE as the unbundled Collection service provider.
- 6. Where service is provided to any customer by an APESP or an ESP, the APESP or ESP shall be responsible for arranging and paying for all generation, transmission, and required ancillary services that may be required to provide such service or services at no cost to MWE for its customers who choose to use unbundled service.



This rate will remain in effect pending future action by MWE and the Commission. 

A program for the Company to assist its customers with their high water-use inquiries and complaints (Modified Non-Per Capita Conservation Program BMP Category 3: Outreach Services 3.6: Customer High Water Use Inquiry Resolution).

#### **REQUIREMENTS**

The requirements of this tariff are governed by Rules of the Arizona Corporation Commission and were adapted from the Arizona Department of Water Resources' Required Public Education Program and Best Management Practices in the Modified Non-Per Capita Conservation Program.

- 1. The Company shall handle high water use inquiries as calls are received.
- 2. Calls shall be taken by a customer service representative who, has been trained on typical causes of high water consumption as well as leak detection procedures that customers can perform themselves.
- 3. Upon request by the customer or when the Company determines it is warranted, a trained Field Technician shall be sent to the customer's residence to conduct a leak detection inspection and provide the customer with water conservation measures. The leak detection inspection may consist of a meter read check for flow verification. If the on-site inspection is requested by the customer, the Commission approved meter re-read tariff fee shall apply.
- 4. The Company shall follow up in some way on every customer inquiry or complaint and keep a record of inquiries and follow-up activities.

# <u>Customer High Water Use Notification Tariff – BMP 3.7</u>

#### <u>PURPOSE</u>

A program for the Company to monitor and notify customers when water use seems to be abnormally high and provide information that could benefit those customers and promote water conservation (Modified Non-Per Capita Conservation Program BMP Category 3: Outreach Services Program 3.7: Customer High Water Use Notification).

#### REQUIREMENTS

The requirements of this tariff are governed by Rules of the Arizona Corporation Commission and were adapted from the Arizona Department of Water Resources' Required Public Education Program and Best Management Practices in the Modified Non-Per Capita Conservation Program.

- 1. The Company shall track water usage for each customer and notify the customer if water use seems excessive for that particular billing for that time of the year.
- 2. The Company shall identify customers with high consumption and investigate each instance to determine the possible cause.
- 3. The Company shall contact the high water use customers via telephone, email, by mail or in person. The Company shall contact the customer as soon as practical in order to minimize the possible loss of water. The customer will not be required to do anything to receive this notification.
- 4. In the notification the Company shall explain some of the most common water usage problems and common solutions and points of contact for dealing with the issues.
- 5. In the notification, the customer will be reminded of at least the following water-saving precautions:
  - a. Check for leaks, running toilets, or valves or flappers that need to be replaced.
  - b. Check landscape watering system valves periodically for leaks and keep sprinkler heads in good shape.
  - c. Adjust sprinklers so only the vegetation is watered and not the house, sidewalk, or street, etc.
  - d. Continue water conservation efforts with any pools such as installing covers on pools and spas and checking for leaks around pumps.
- 6. In the notification, the customer will also be reminded of at least the following ordinary life events that can cause a spike in water usage:
  - a. More people in the home than usual taking baths and showers.
  - b. Doing more loads of laundry than usual.
  - c. Doing a landscape project or starting a new lawn.
  - d. Washing vehicles more often than usual.

7. The Company shall provide water conservation information that could benefit the customer, such as, but not limited to, audit programs, publications, and rebate programs.

- 8. The Company shall assist the customer in a self-water audit and assist the customer in determining what might be causing the high water usage as well as supply customer with information regarding water conservation and landscape watering guidelines. As part of the water audit the Company shall confirm the accuracy of the customer meter if requested to do so by the customer (applicable meter testing fees shall apply).
- 9. The type of notification, the timing of the notification (i.e., how long after high water use was discovered by the Company), and the criteria used for determining which customers are notified shall be recorded and made available to the Commission upon request.

# **WATER SYSTEM TAMPERING TARIFF - BMP 5.2**

#### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this tariff is to promote the conservation of groundwater by enabling the Company to bring an action for damages or to enjoin any activity against a person who tampers with the water system.

#### **REQUIREMENTS:**

The requirements of this tariff are governed by Rules of the Arizona Corporation Commission, specifically Arizona Administrative Code ("AAC") R14-2-410 and the Arizona Department of Water Resources' Required Public Education Program and Best Management Practices in the Modified Non-Per Capita Conservation Program.

- 1. In support of the Company's water conservation goals, the Company may bring an action for damages or to enjoin any activity against a person who: (1) makes a connection or reconnection with property owned or used by the Company to provide utility service without the Company's authorization or consent; (2) prevents a Company meter or other device used to determine the charge for utility services from accurately performing its measuring function; (3) tampers with property owned or used by the Company; or (4) uses or receives the Company's services without the authorization or consent of the Company and knows or has reason to know of the unlawful diversion, tampering or connection. If the Company's action is successful, the Company may recover as damages three times the amount of actual damages.
- 2. Compliance with the provisions of this tariff will be a condition of service.
- 3. The Company shall provide to all its customers, upon request, a complete copy of this tariff and AAC R14-2-410. The customers shall follow and abide by this tariff.
- 4. If a customer is connected to the Company water system and the Company discovers that the customer has taken any of the actions listed in No. 1 above, the Company may terminate service per AAC R14-2-410.
- 5. If a customer believes he/she has been disconnected in error, the customer may contact the Commission's Consumer Services Section at 1-800-222-7000 to initiate an investigation.
