Preparing to launch an In Line Inspection Tool (AKA Smart Pig or ILI tool)







ILI completed in 2008 to 2012

In line Inspection (ILI) completed on final 42 miles from Mohave, AZ to Essex, CA Section 3



Remaining Assessment Schedule

Continue non critical anomaly investigation from 2012 ILI survey.

42 miles, ILI Mohave to Essex, California Section 3 Completed in 2013.

• Complete investigative digs on this 42 miles.





Cathodic Protection

Cathodic Protection Enhancements

- The installation of Remote Monitors complete and operational
- Monitoring 46 cathodic protection stations across NM, UT, AZ, CA
- 24 hour monitoring
- Improved response time, less down time
- Facilitates pipeline protection verification testing.

QUESTAR Southern Trails Pipeline

Kayenta AZ Class 3 extension project

- Extend Class 3 heavy wall pipe by 1890 feet.
- Extension is on both sides of Kayenta East and West.
- Class 3 extension due to population growth in Kayenta.
- Met with Kayenta Township to communicate project schedule and plans.
- Worked with local distribution company Navajo Tribal Utility Authority (NTUA) to schedule work during off peak hours (weekend).





2013 Damage Prevention Emergency Response Public Awareness Meetings

Coordinated with Arizona Blue Stake, local utility and transmission companies and the Arizona Corporation Commission Staff.

Purpose Of Meetings

- QUESTAR Southern Trails Pipeline
- Inform the public and cities, of pipelines in their vicinity and their locations.
- Train excavators on Blue Stake laws, excavation safety, and safe marking practices.
- Make emergency responders and public officials aware of pipelines and high consequence areas in their response zones.
- Train emergency responders on leak recognition and response Product hazards and characteristics.
- Share pipeline emergency numbers and introduce local pipeline operators to public and responders.
- Define Emergency Planning partners pipeline operators, police, fire, ambulance hospitals, LEPC, and public officials.





In Summary : The Benefits of Transmission Integrity Management

- Thorough, up to date analysis of pipeline integrity
- " Continue smart pigging" at 7 year intervals.
- Remote monitoring and control of cathodic protection.
- 100% of Southern Trails was hydrostatically tested to DOT code requirements in 2001.





Summary of The Benefits of Public Communication

- Provides a foundation for incident avoidance through communications with emergency responders, public officials, excavators and the general public.
- Give knowledge to local communities of pipelines in their area
