IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF WEST CAMP WIND FARM, LLC, IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF **ARIZONA** REVISED STATUTES, SECTIONS 40-360, et. seq., FOR CERTIFICATES **ENVIRONMENTAL** AUTHORIZING THE WEST CAMP WIND GEN-TIE PROJECT, 345 KV 500 A OR TRANSMISSION LINE AND ASSOCIATED **FACILITIES** INTERCONNECTION WITHIN NAVAJO COUNTY, ARIZONA.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the general public, the parties and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee ("Committee"), that the Committee will hold a public meeting/hearing on the above application that is open to the public at the High Country Conference Center, located at 201 West Butler Avenue, Flagstaff, Arizona 86001, commencing on Tuesday, October 11, 2022, at 1:00 p.m., and will continue each weekday on Wednesday, October 12 through Thursday, October 13, 2022, as necessary, at the same location beginning at 9:00 a.m. on each day. No tour of the Project area is planned by the Chairman at this time. If the Chairman or Committee later decide to conduct a tour, notice that includes a map and itinerary of any such tour will be available at the hearing and posted on the Project website website https://www.aes.com/west-camp-wind and the ACC at: https://www.azcc.gov/arizona-power-plant/meeting-schedule.

Public comment will be taken in a special evening session on Tuesday, October 11, 2022, at 5:30 p.m. and may be taken at the beginning of each hearing day or at other times during the hearing at times designated by the Chairman. Unless later ordered by the Chairman, the hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. each day, except on

Tuesday, October 11, 2022, when it will continue after 5:00 p.m. for the public comment session.

The hearing may conclude earlier or later than anticipated, depending upon the number of parties that intervene, the amount of testimony presented, the amount of public comment, and the time needed for deliberations by the Committee. As a part of the public meeting/hearing, members of the Committee will discuss the potential value of a tour, and, at the discretion of the Chairman, may tour the location of the proposed project area as set forth above.

DUE TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC, THE PUBLIC IS STRONGLY ENCOURAGED TO PARTICIPATE BY EITHER WATCHING THE MEETING ONLINE OR LISTENING TO THE MEETING VIA TELEPHONE, RATHER THAN ATTENDING IN PERSON.

PUBLIC COMMENT WILL BE TAKEN IN A SPECIAL EVENING SESSION ON TUESDAY, OCTOBER 11, 2022, AT 5:30 P.M., VIA TELEPHONE, ZOOM, OR IN PERSON AT THE HIGH COUNTRY CONFERENCE CENTER LOCATED AT 201 WEST BUTLER AVENUE, FLAGSTAFF, ARIZONA 86001.

PUBLIC COMMENT MAY ALSO BE TAKEN AT OTHER TIMES DURING THE HEARING AT THE DISCRETION OF THE COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN.

PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT THE PUBLIC HEARING AND PUBLIC COMMENT SESSION WILL FOLLOW CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL, AS WELL AS STATE AND LOCAL GUIDELINES ADDRESSING COVID-19.
