December 6, 2022, through Wednesday, December 7, 2022, as necessary, at the same location beginning at 9:00 a.m. on each day. If a tour is taken, it will begin on an alternative date and time set by the Chairman of the Committee ("Chairman").

No tour of the Project area is planned by the Chairman at this time.
