Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the general public, the parties and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee ("Committee"), that the Committee will hold a public meeting/hearing on the above application that is open to the public at the Hampton Inn & Suites Phoenix-Goodyear, located at 2000 North Litchfield Road, Goodyear, Arizona 85395, commencing on March 27, 2023, at 1:00 p.m., and will continue on March 28, 2023, as necessary, at the same location beginning at 9:00 a.m. on each day, unless a tour is taken. If a tour is taken, it will begin on an alternative date and time set by the Chairman of the Committee ("Chairman").

Public comment will be taken in a special afternoon session on March 27, 2023 at 2:00 p.m. and may be taken at the beginning of each hearing day or at other times during the hearing at times designated by the Chairman. Unless later ordered by the Chairman, the hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m.



19 with or between Committee members about the application or matters
20 relating to the application will take place, except on the record before a court
21 reporter at the designated stops. The Chairman will make any procedural
22 decisions concerning stops at different points of interest;

24 environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of
25 environmental compatibility;
- 26 9. Vote and decision concerning findings of fact, conclusions of law, the
27 certificate of environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of
28 environmental compatibility;
