Range 14 East), with interconnection at the planned Vine Substation (Section 06, Township 14 South, Range 14 East), and terminating at the existing DeMoss-Petrie Substation (Section 35, Township 13 South, Range 13 East), each located within the City of Tucson, Pima County, Arizona.

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### **NOTICE OF HEARING**

A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD before the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee ("Committee") regarding the Application of Tucson Electric Power Company ("Applicant") for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility authorizing the construction of the Kino to DeMoss-Petrie ("DMP") 138 kilovolt ("kV") Transmission Line Project ("Project") (the "Application") in Pima County, Arizona.

The Project consists of building a new, single circuit, 138 kV transmission line totaling 7.2 to 8.1 miles in length, depending on the alternative approved, to connect the existing Kino Substation to the existing DMP Substation. The Project will also interconnect to the planned Vine 138 kV Substation. The Project will cross private, City of Tucson ("COT"), Pima County, U.S. Postal Service, and Arizona Board of Regents owned land, as well as COT road right-of-way. A map of the Project is attached as

Exhibit A.

The hearing on the Application will be held at the **Doubletree Hotel**, located at 445 S. Alvernon Way, Tucson, AZ 85711. The hearing will commence on September 13, 2021 at 1:00 p.m. and continue on September 14, 2021 through September 17, 2021 beginning at 9:00 a.m. each day, unless a tour is taken. If a tour is taken, it will begin on Wednesday, September 15, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. or an alternative date and time set by the Chairman of the Committee ("Chairman"). If necessary, the hearing will thereafter continue on September 20, 2021, beginning at 1:00 p.m. and will continue on September 21, 2021 through September 24, 2021, commencing at 9:00 a.m. each day as necessary.

PUBLIC COMMENT WILL BE TAKEN IN A SPECIAL EVENING SESSION ON SEPTEMBER 13, 2021, BEGINNING AT 5:30 P.M., VIA TELEPHONE, ZOOM, OR IN PERSON, AT THE DOUBLETREE HOTEL. PUBLIC COMMENT MAY ALSO BE TAKEN AT THE BEGINNING OF EACH HEARING DAY, OR AT OTHER TIMES DURING THE HEARING, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CHAIRMAN.

PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT THE PUBLIC HEARING AND PUBLIC COMMENT SESSION WILL FOLLOW CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL, AS WELL AS STATE AND LOCAL GUIDELINES ADDRESSING COVID-19. FURTHER RESTRICTIONS ON PUBLIC ACCESS, ADDITIONAL SAFETY PROTOCOLS, AND REVISIONS TO THE HEARING SCHEDULE MAY OCCUR DUE TO PUBLIC HEALTH CONSIDERSATIONS.

The date, time, and place at which the hearing will be resumed will be posted on the above-noted Project and ACC websites. NOTE: NOTICE OF ANY SUCH RESUMED HEARING WILL BE GIVEN; HOWEVER, PUBLISHED NOTICE OF SUCH A RESUMED HEARING IS NOT REQUIRED.

The Committee may conduct a tour of the Project area. The map and itinerary of any such tour will be available at the hearing and posted on the Project website. Members of the public may follow the Committee on the tour. During the tour, the Committee may hear testimony at stops on the tour concerning where the stops are located, what is visible at stops, and the relevance of the location and view to the Application and Project. No other discussion or deliberation concerning the Application will occur during the tour. A court reporter or recording device will record any testimony taken on the tour for transcription. COVID-19 protocols specific for the tour will be included on the itinerary.

Any domestic non-profit corporation or association formed in whole or in part to promote conservation or natural beauty; to protect the environment, personal health or other biological values; to preserve historical sites; to promote consumer interests; to represent commercial and industrial groups; or to promote the orderly development of the area in which the Project is located that desires to become a party to the proceedings shall, not less than ten (10) days before September 13, 2021, file a Notice of Intent to Become a Party with the Director of Utilities, ACC, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007.

The Committee or the Chairman, at any time deemed appropriate, may make other persons parties to the proceedings.

Any person may make a limited appearance at a hearing by filing a statement in writing with the Director of Utilities, ACC, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007, not less than five (5) days before September 13, 2021. A person making a limited appearance will not be a party or have the right to present testimony or cross-examine

witnesses.

This proceeding is governed by Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S.") §§ 40-360 to 40-360.13 and Arizona Administrative Code Rules R14-3-201 to R14-3-220. Substantive communication not in the public record may be made to any member of the Committee. The written decision of the Committee will be submitted to the ACC pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-360.07. Any person intending to be a party to the proceeding on the matter before the ACC must be a party to the proceedings before the Committee.
