NOTICE OF HEARING

A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD before the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee ("Committee") regarding the application ("Application") of DCR Transmission, L.L.C. ("DCR") for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility ("CEC") authorizing construction of the Arizona portion of the Ten West Link 500-kilovolt ("kV") Transmission Line Project (the "Project").

The Arizona portion of the Project will consist of a 500-kV electric transmission line and associated infrastructure to run approximately 103.4 miles from Arizona Public Service Company's ("APS") Delaney Substation near Tonopah, Arizona until it crosses the Colorado River into California. A map of the Project is attached as Exhibit A.

The Committee may conduct a helicopter tour of the Project area. The map of any such tour and a script to be read verbatim by the tour guide during the tour, including the identification of hover points by specific GPS coordinates, will be presented as an exhibit at the hearing and posted on the Project website. The Committee will not ask any questions of the tour guide or otherwise discuss the Project during the tour, and the reading of the script by the tour guide will be recorded for later transcription and entered into the record. No other discussion or deliberation concerning the Application will occur during the tour. On January 27, 2020, beginning at 4:00 p.m., the Committee will meet at the Riggles RV and Event Center to ask questions and hear testimony regarding the tour. A court reporter or recording device will record any testimony taken before or after the tour for transcription.

The Committee or the Chairman, at any time deemed appropriate, may make other persons parties to the proceedings. Any person may make a limited appearance at a hearing by filing a statement in writing with the Director of Utilities, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1220 West Washington Street, Phoenix AZ 85007, not less than five (5) days before January 22, 2020. A person making a limited appearance will not be a party or have the right to present testimony or cross-examine witnesses.

This proceeding is governed by Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S.") §§ 40-360 to 40-360.13 and Arizona Administrative Code ("A.A.C.") R14-3-201 to R14-3-220. No substantive communication, not in the public record, may be made to any member of the Committee. The written decision of the Committee will be submitted to the Commission pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-360.07. Any person intending to be a party to the proceeding on the matter before the Commission must be a party to the proceeding before the Committee.
